

HOW TO SAFELY
DISPOSE OF PET
WASTE.

DOG AND CAT WASTE POLLUTES OUR WATERSHEDS!

Pet waste left on the street or lawn does not just go away or fertilize the grass. The bacteria in the waste is washed down storm drains and into ditches, streams, lakes, and inlets, and can travel for miles in the water. Pet waste contains harmful bacteria such as E. Coli and fecal coliform. Waters that contain a high amount of bacteria are unfit for human contact. While it may not seem like a big deal if one more dog or cat "contributes" some waste to the neighborhood environment, think about how many animals there are out there!



- Clean up after your pets every single time. Encourage neighbors to do the same.
- Teach children how to properly clean up after pets.
- Take advantage of the complimentary waste bags offered in dispensers at parks and greenways.
- Reuse your plastic bags (bread bags, newspaper bags, grocery bags, etc.)
- Carry extra bags when walking your pet or when traveling. Offer extra bags to owners who are without their own bags.

PROPER PET WASTE DISPOSAL



Waste Pickup Bags in a Holder that clips onto your leash are a convenient way to ensure you are always prepared to clean up after your pet.



DISPOSE OF KITTY LITTER AND WASTE PROPERLY

Never dump cat waste and used kitty litter on the ground. When cleaning out the kitty litter box, a two-step approach is the most effective. Cat waste may be scooped out and flushed down the toilet. After scooping out the waste, the used litter should be bagged, sealed securely and placed in the trash.



Dumping the entire contents of the litter box down your toilet may cause plumbing problems.
